What is Adopt Your Drain?

Adopt Your Drain is an opportunity to prevent street flooding & some forms of stormwater pollution by clearing storm drains of debris.

What is Stormwater Pollution?

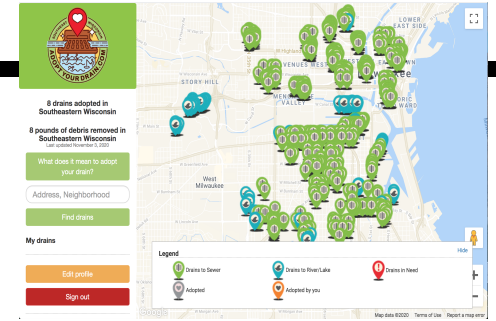
Stormwater pollution is rainwater that has picked up litter, chemicals, yard & pet waste, and other pollutants, carrying them into our local rivers & lakes.

STEP 1

Visit www.AdoptYourDrain.com and create an account.

Click the Register / Sign In Button and add your

Choose your drain.

STEP 2

Use the search bar to look up your address & select a drain near you!

Depending on your community, you might adopt a storm drain or a stormwater ditch.



STEP 3

Clean your drain.

Clean yard waste, litter, and other debris on the 1st and 15th of the month, and before and after rainfall.



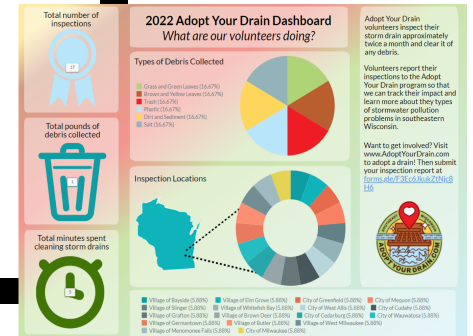
STEP 4

Report your volunteerism.
